

**SUMMARY OF TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS OR THE TECHNICAL PART OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTATION RELATING TO THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT**

**»Maintenance of Security System Equipment«**

The subject of this public procurement is the maintenance of technical security systems for a period of 5 years at the contracting authorities, totalling 6 of them. The contracting authorities require, as part of the system maintenance service, the performance of regular maintenance on video surveillance, burglar alarm, intercom, and perimeter security systems, as well as the performance of emergency maintenance (fault repair) on video surveillance, burglar alarm, intercom, and perimeter security systems.

The provider will perform system maintenance as follows:

- regular maintenance of video surveillance systems – one (1) inspection per year at each location,
- regular maintenance of burglar alarm systems – one (1) inspection per year at each location,
- regular maintenance of intercom systems – one (1) inspection per year at each location,
- regular maintenance of perimeter security systems – one (1) inspection per year at each location,
- emergency maintenance (fault repair) upon each request by the client in accordance with the required response times.

Selected contractor will maintain the technical security systems at nearly 30 locations belonging to public contracting authorities throughout the Republic of Slovenia at are associated with a power plant or other facility.

The bidders must hold a valid license to operate technical security systems under the Private Security Act (ZZasV-1) and must be included on the publicly accessible list of issued licenses maintained by the Ministry of the Interior of Republic of Slovenija. In addition, the bidders must provide all professional licenses/certificates and meet the other eligibility requirements specified in the public part of the documentation.

To protect particularly sensitive data, the contracting authority, in accordance with Article 61(2) of the Public Procurement Act of the Republic of Slovenia, cannot publish the entire documentation related to the public procurement on the public procurement portal. The part of the documentation that must be reviewed for participation in the public procurement procedure and for the preparation of a bid is considered a trade secret in accordance with the regulations governing the contracting authority's operations, as it contains important information about the operations or business of the contracting authorities, and its disclosure could harm the contracting authorities; therefore, the contracting authority is not required to disclose such information to the public. For the reasons stated above, some parts of documentation is marked as confidential.

The confidential part of the documentation may only be obtained by potential bidders who, as of the date of signing the form for obtaining confidential documentation:

- 1) hold a license for the implementation of technical security systems under the Private Security Act of the Republic of Slovenia (ZZasV-1), and are included in the publicly available list of such licenses issued by the Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of Slovenia; and
- 2) hold a valid national security clearance at the "CONFIDENTIAL" level, issued in the Republic of Slovenia.

The remaining detailed technical requirements of this public procurement are set forth in the confidential part of the documentation, which potential bidders must obtain in a timely manner, along with submitting evidence of compliance with the eligibility criteria.

In case of potential differences between Slovenian text in the public procurement documentation relating to the award of the contract and this summary in English translation, the Slovenian version takes precedence.
